LOSTWITHIEL CRICKET FESTIVAL

THE EVENT:

- A 6-a-side knock-out cricket competition in which teams will be issued with a coloured playing shirts for the event.
- Each side is required to field a minimum of one youth player aged between 10 and 14 **OR** one person aged 70 or over on the day of the competition, **AND** one female.
- Please note this is intended as a 'fun' event and therefore **NOT** open to personnel playing league cricket
- Matches will commence at 5.30pm. If a team is not ready to play at the start of their allotted time, they will forfeit the game.
- Games will be played on a full sized pitch (22 yards) using a soft ball. Each match will consist of one innings per side of 5overs with Boconnoc CC providing umpires and scorers. Should inclement weather dictate then early round matches may be reduced in overs as necessary.
- In the event of a tied game the team losing least wickets will be declared the winners.
- A bar & BBQ will be available throughout the evening.
- Trophies will be presented to the winners & runner up at the Royal Oak when the final is completed.

COMPETITION RULES:

BATTING:

- On reaching 15 runs, the batsman/woman will retire, however they can return to the wicket if the remaining batsmen/women are all out. They will return in the same order in which they retired and the last player can continue on his/her own either until they are out or the 5 overs are completed.
- A rubber ball will be used hence the wearing of protective cricket equipment (pads, gloves etc), is optional.

BOWLING:

- Each outfield player required to bowl one over each. The wicket keeper will be unable to bowl.
- A bowler can bowl over-arm or under-arm providing the umpire is informed before the over starts. The player is not permitted to change their action during the over.
- A wide ball will result in the batting team receiving 2 runs; however this will not be re-bowled unless the last ball of the innings which must be a legal delivery.
- A no-ball will be called if the ball bounces twice or more before it reaches the batsman/woman. This will result in the batting team being awarded 2 runs. The ball will not be re-bowled unless the last of the innings, which must be a legal delivery.
- A batsman/woman cannot be dismissed LBW.

To enable things to run smoothly there will be Boconnoc CC manned assembly points for pitches A & B. Approximately 10 - 15 minutes before matches in which you are competing are scheduled to start an announcement will be made over the tannoy asking your team to go to the relevant assembly point. Here a representative of Boconnoc CC will oversee the toss and generally ensure you're ready to take the field as soon as the match in progress finishes. To this end would you please appoint a Captain to ensure your team go to the assembly point when asked to do so.

It is essential that we start on time at 5.30pm!!
