RULES

TRAINERS ONLY TO BE WORN

Normal football rules apply with the following exceptions:

There is no “off side rule”.

The ball should not exceed head height.

All “throw ins”, “goal kicks”, and “corner kicks” to be rolled in under arm.

No player should step inside the semi-circle surrounding the goals.

The goalkeeper cannot step outside the semi-circle surrounding the goal.

One substitute only per team allowed.

The referee’s decision is final.

The matches will be of 5 minutes duration each half. Sudden death penalties will be taken in the event of a draw in the knock out stage.

No bad language on the field of play.

Only Team Managers or Captains can approach the committee table.

No mixed teams allowed.

Team captains are responsible for the actions of their players
