Notes:

- * Entrants should bring appropriate footwear/headwear/clothing/waterproofs/sun cream **and carry sufficient water or other drink. DRINKS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED en route.**
- * Food is available from a catering facility at Thurston (caterer's normal prices apply).
- * Entrants are responsible for their own return transport from checkpoints. However:
- * Minibuses will be available from Wirral Country Park at Thurston between **12.30 pm and 5.30 pm** to West Kirby Station (£1 donation) and Seacombe Ferry Terminal (£3 donation).
- * Car parking close to the finish will be available from 8.00 am until 6.00 pm on the day of the walk. Local Authority charges may apply.
- * Walkers may be collected by vehicle without incurring parking charges if they are at the designated pick-up bay when the collecting vehicle arrives (otherwise collecting vehicle must park).
- * Entrants participate at their own risk. Children under 16 years of age should be accompanied by an adult.
- * Considerable efforts are made to provide sufficient toilets. Please see map (on website or available at Registration) for locations.
