Associate Membership Programme

Our Associate Membership Programme gives prospective members the opportunity to experience at first hand the work and fellowship of our Club for an extended, but fixed, period before making a decision on whether to become an active member. An individual can be an Associate Member for a maximum of two years.

Why should I become an Associate Member?

You are recognized within the Club and can attend any Club meeting and function

Networking opportunities are endless. Rotary consists of a wide cross section from every business community and its members come from all walks of life.

You can get involved in running a project; you will learn and develop new skills from our experienced Club members. Rotarians report improvements in skills such as event management, time management, team working, and leadership.

You pay no Rotary fees, although there may be a small Club charge.

You receive regular updates on all our Club functions.

There are no attendance requirements.

You can convert from Associate Membership to Full Membership at any time, subject to Club rules.

While undertaking a Club project you are covered by Rotary insurance.

Our members have a lot of fun! Our club arranges activities which gives our members the chance to forge new friendships with like-minded people who share common goals.

What restrictions are there?

You will not be an official member of Rotary and will not receive Rotary International or Rotary in Great Britain and Ireland literature, reports, offers, etc.

You cannot hold any Club officer position; you can however run a Rotary Project.

You can only remain an Associate Member for up to two years.

You cannot vote on Club matters
