How does it work?

Members are invited to contribute at the rate of £12 per year per share. Each share is allocated a number which is entered into four quarterly prize draws. Half of the contributions go to charity and the other half is returned to members through the quarterly prize draws.

Prizes

The value of each quarterly prize draw depends upon the number of paid up shareholders at the date of the prize draw.

RULES OF THE ROTARY INTERNATIONAL 200 CLUB

1. Only subscribing members of the Rotary International 200 Club are allowed to participate in the draw.
2. The only right attaching to membership is eligibility to participate in the draw.
3. Subscriptions for each share shall be £12 per annum payable by standing order, electronic transfer or cheque.
4. Any member who falls into arrears shall forfeit automatically the right to be included in any subsequent draws until the arrears are paid.
5. Every share purchased shall, subject to Rule 4, participate in the quarterly prize draw. Subscribers in any quarter shall be eligible for the draw the following quarter.
6. On no account shall the promoter pay any prize to any person other than the purchaser of the winning share.
7. No subscription will be refunded.
8. If there is insufficient interest to continue the draw the remaining funds for prizes will be distributed by way of a final draw.
9. The members of Ashtead Rotary Club have duly appointed the member holding the office of '200 Club Promoter' as Promoter of the draw.
10. In the event of any dispute the decision of the Promoter and the Council of Ashtead Rotary Club shall be final and binding.
11. Half of all subscriptions shall be returned to shareholders as prizes. The other half, less expenses shall go to international charities and other worthy causes determined by the International Service Committee of Ashtead Rotary Club.
12. Prizes shall be distributed to winners quarterly. All participants shall be advised of prize winners at the end of the year.
13. The competition is conducted under the provisions of the Lotteries and amusements Act 1976.
