THAME SWIMATHON 2016 (“THE EVENT”) - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BY COMPLETING AND SUBMITTING AN ENTRY FORM, ENTRANTS AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Persons aged under 16 years at the date of their application must obtain the consent of their parent or guardian to enter the Event. The parent or guardian must sign the Entry Form next to the person’s name.

No entrant may be under 8 years of age.

By completing and submitting a Team Entry form, the Entrants, or in the case of Entrants under 16 years of age their parents/guardians:

- accept that they have considered the risks involved in participating in the Event, and believe that the Entrant is healthy and fit to swim; and
- understand and accept that the Entrant participates at his/her own risk, and
- confirm that the Entrant can swim well enough to be safe in a 3 ft deep 25 metre pool
- do not take any photographs at the Thame Leisure Centre

Entrants must adhere at all times to the rules and regulations of the Thame Leisure Centre while there for the Event.
