## Walking for Water - a Speaker for Your Club

**Walking for Water**

My name is Richard Galliford.  
Currently  
President 2018/19: Stainborough Rotary Club  
Secretary: Ghana Outlook, Reg UK Charity

**Target 500 miles**

For 20 years I have been involved in charity work in Ghana, West Africa. I am proud that Ghana Outlook has been able to help many communities over the years and friends and Rotary have always been there to help fund the various projects that we done. Most of the last two decades has been about providing clean drinking water to the deprived areas of Ghana. I have seen the need for this basic life necessity more times than I would have liked to. As a new project I have set myself the challenge of walking and logging 500 miles since walking is what many women and children have to do every day in Ghana in order to look for water which even then, sadly, is mostly unfit to drink. A child dies in the world every one and half minutes through consuming dirty diseased water. Others may need to have a limb amputated to survive.

This project is to fund raise for a charitable clinic and maternity hospital in Ghana known as the Notre Dame Clinic. Last year the clinic treated 18000 patients. Sister Cecilia who has helped there for 25 years has asked for help. Their old well is no longer any good and money now has to be spent on buying water from the nearby town, which in many cases is not pure. Such purchasing also presents an extra annual expense. Having a borehole would save money that could be better spent on treatment and care at the clinic as well as providing water, which would be much safer to drink. My promise to her is that I would do my best to help fund a new water borehole at a cost of £4500 which would provide clean water.
