Privacy Statement

The Rotary Club of Oswestry considers the privacy of personal data and compliance with GDPR as a very high priority.

In the case of the annual Tree of Light Appeal it holds personal data relating to people who subscribe to the appeal in order to promote the charitable aims of the scheme and to fulfil its Gift Aid and other accounting obligations.

The Club currently holds name and address information, details of donation amounts/ dates and whether donors are UK tax payers. This data may be held for up to seven years. In the future, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses may also be held.

The Club will not share this information with any third party except where required to do so by law or other regulation.

Where donors opt to have a dedication entered in the Book of Remembrance, only the dedication wording provided by the donor will be entered and the book will be on public display for a period of up to one year after which it will be safely destroyed.

Previous donors are invited by letter to contribute to each year's appeal if they have ticked the communications opt-in box with a previous donation. This is the only communication donors should normally expect when they opt in.
