An Imagination Library is a gift from a community to its children.

The Dolly Parton Imagination Library is an international project that provides young children with free, age appropriate books, each month, from birth up to the age of five.

In 1995, Dolly started the Imagination Library in her home state of Tennessee. Dolly personally pays for all the children in Sevier County to receive a book each month.

The Imagination Library provides young children up to the age of 5 with free, age appropriate books, each month.

Salford, Starting Life Well service started the first Imagination Library for all Looked After Children, from birth to 5 years, in Salford.

In addition, Salford currently has one school registering children for an Imagination Library. This is for children living in the Duchy Estate, who either attend [Summerville Primary School, M6 7HB](#), or who have older siblings attending the school. It currently provides books for up to 90 members of the library.
