

STONEHOUSE ROTARY COMMUNITY AWARDS 2019

The aim of the Community Awards programme is to support organisations within the Stonehouse area where a small grant will make a real and lasting difference. This is a programme with awards of up to a maximum of £500 and organisations that already have significant assets or turnover will not be considered.

This programme started in 2018 and it was encouraging not only to see the response by newly formed community organisations but also the creative ways in which the grants were used. For details of previous Award winners please see the website of the Rotary Club of Stonehouse.

Community Award Application Criteria

The maximum award to any one organisation is £500 and no application will be considered to be too small.

Priority will be given to projects promoted by ***small*** groups or organisations:-

- That offer good value for money because their work benefits a significant number of people;
- That work with vulnerable or disadvantaged children or adults;
- That work in a deprived community;
- Whose staff are generally volunteers - applications for payment of salaries will not be considered.

Eligibility

The funding is open to registered charities, voluntary organisations and community groups whose work benefits local residents or communities in Stonehouse and surrounding area.

Application Process and Submission

Interested groups/organisations should complete the attached application form.

Applicants will need to provide a copy of their latest accounts or financial statement.

NOTE: Failure to enclose such document will disqualify the application.

Please do not enclose any original documents or additional paperwork – we will contact you if any other documents are required

Assessment and Decision Making

1. Applications will be logged on receipt and checked for their eligibility to apply.
2. Applications will then be assessed by a panel from the Rotary Club of Stonehouse.
3. Successful applicants will be notified by post or e-mail and will be invited to attend a meeting to celebrate the awards and talk briefly about their project.
4. Successful applicants agree to use the Rotary logo on publicity and promotional material for their project and to submit a report on progress/impact of the project.
5. The decision of the Rotary Club of Stonehouse will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

We will be making a database of applications and will hold details of the organisation and personal details of those representing the organisation. Please refer to the Privacy Policy on our websites for further information.
