Emergency shelter in the aftermath of a disaster is vital for communities to rebuild: a short-term solution for a long-term goal. Your support allows our highly trained ShelterBox response teams to go the extra mile to find the people left most vulnerable after a disaster – to make sure that no one gets forgotten or left behind.

Last year we helped over 210,000 people. That's over 30,000 families supported with emergency shelter aid and other essential household items: tents, tarpaulins, tool kits, blankets, mosquito nets, solar lights, cooking sets, water carriers and water filters.

Donations such as this one made it possible for ShelterBox to respond 18 times in 17 different countries during 2018. Let's make sure we can continue to provide communities with the tools to start their own recovery, in 2019 and beyond.

In the aftermath of Cyclone Idai, flooding has affected almost 1 million Malawians and forced at least 125,000 from their homes. We currently have a team in Malawi, to assess damages to homes and get a better understanding of how we may be able to help communities.
