Variable Height Couch

As part of the recent extension of the HW Surgery examination couches have been installed in three new consulting rooms.

Ordinarily the couches would have been static height models, but with the aid of funding from **Hart Rotary** it has been possible to purchase electric adjustable ones, allowing frail, elderly or unstable patients to get on and off more safely as they can be lowered to assist them and then raised to allow examination by GP or nurse.

Glad's House

Glad's House is a local charity with a long reach. Set up in Hook in 2006 in collaboration with a group of Kenyan Social Workers it responds to the needs of street children in Mombassa.

The charity works with children living and working on the streets, on dumpsites, in prisons and in the community – those deemed “too challenging” and given up on by the rest of society. Last year they treated 1580 such cases.



Fresh hope – street soccer

First Aid often has to be provided to dress wounds and attend to complaints resulting from sleeping on the streets, when doctors and hospitals refuse to treat them. **Hart Rotary** has therefore donated £1000 to purchase First Aid supplies to be used in this work.
