### MARY'S MEALS

In the poorest countries in the world hungry children think about survival, not school. In order to survive they have to work in the fields or streets, and even if they make it into school, hunger affects their ability to learn.

But this can be prevented. **Mary's Meals** is a charity which provides one daily meal in a school where they can receive an education that can be their ladder out of poverty.

The charity began by feeding 200 children in Malawi in 2002. Today they feed around 1.2m children daily in 16 countries in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean. In this work they rely to a very large extent on the work of volunteers, and on donations.

The average cost of feeding a child with their special formula porridge for a whole school year is about £14, and **Hart Rotary has donated £1,400** to support 100 children for a whole year.
