..Parity for Disability



Helping hands

When full-time education comes to an end young people with multiple disabilities find that the support they could count on as children declines dramatically, and for some it is like falling off a cliff.

Locally, however, we are fortunate to have the services of **Parity for Disability**, a Farnborough based charity which provides trained, caring staff to meet the care and communication needs of people aged 18+ who suffer multiple disability.

The services provided range across physio, speech, communication and music therapy at 3 local Day Service Centres, and also entail working in residential and family homes. The majority of "students" live with their families, so family carers receive some much-needed respite.

A unique feature of Parity's service is Activity Schemes in Easter and Summer holidays, where young people do the indoor and outdoor activities that other youngsters take for granted. These schemes are funded in part by participants and in part by fundraising from local organisations. We believe that these activities make a significant contribution to the local community, and we have donated **£500** towards the cost this year.

Pram Race Result

The annual Pram Race around Cricket Green was great fun, with races for all types of prams and other manually propelled vehicles.

The event, jointly organised by Hart Rotary, St John's Church and Friends of Hartley Wintney raised over **£1,200 for Naomi House & Jack's Place** with support from Bates and other local businesses
