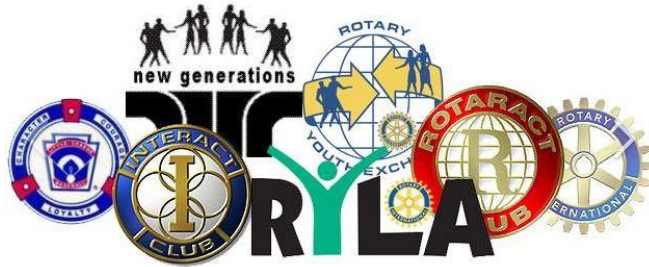
### **Rotary Youth Leadership Awards**
